## Tips for Reading Together

Children learn best when reading is fun.

- Talk about the title and the picture on the front cover.
- Identify the letter patterns *ch* and *ss* in the title and talk about the sounds they make when you read them.
- Look at the *ch* and *oo* words on page 4. Say the sounds in each word and then say the word (e.g. *s-u-ch*, *such*; *s-oo-n*, *soon*).
- Read the story then find the words with *ch*, *oo* and *v*.
- Talk about the story and do the fun activities at the end of the book.

Children enjoy re-reading stories and this helps to build their confidence.

Have fun!



After you have read the story, find the five worms hidden in the pictures.



The main sounds practised in this book are 'ch' as in *Chip*, 'oo' as in *too*, and 'v' as in *Viv*.



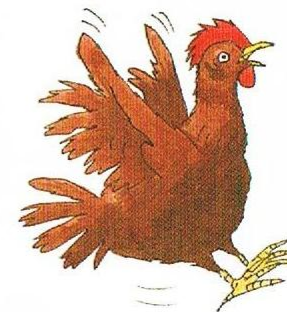
